Parish Census: The Diocese of Eastern PA is collecting parish data for the upcoming year. Please be sure to contact Fr. Stephen if you have any questions about your "membership". **The Christian understanding of "membership" is any Baptized and Chrismated individual who is an active participant in the Sacraments of the Church, and therefore a "member" of the Body of Christ.** For the purpose of this census, another indicator of membership is financial stewardship. Please prayerfully review your current financial stewardship to our parish and consider the "goal" of tithing (*offering a fixed percentage of your income back to God - which is traditionally 10% - please see our recent 'Diocese Alive in Christ' for more teaching on tithing*). **Do the best you can...** the most important part of Christian stewardship is that it is done willingly, prayerfully, and consistently (see 2 Cor. 9:7). **Please see Fr. PARISH AGAPE CANISTER UPDATE: For about 10 years now, we've had an Orthodox Christian Mission Center (OCMC) canister on our church candle desk in the vestibule. Since 1988, the Agape program has raised over \$2 million to feed children, vaccinate babies and bring water to rural areas. For the first six months of this year, our parish's canister has generated \$184.17. **Nick Ressetar** is our parish's Agape partner and is responsible for collecting the monies, filling out a form and remitting them to the OCMC.
