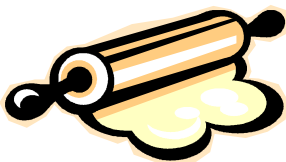

**Orthodox Coffee House Update:** After several months of planning the board of directors of the non-profit organization, the **Orthodox Christian Charities of Greater Harrisburg, Inc** (OCCGH), comprised of clergy and faithful from our five local Orthodox parishes, are drawing closer to realizing a dynamic vision for outreach to the city of Harrisburg in the form of a coffee house and bookstore. **Why?** In order to fulfill our Lord's command to "go forth" and share our rich inheritance and the fullness of the Apostolic Faith as we experience it as Orthodox (literally - "right or correct worshipping") Christians, with those who are hungry for God, and spiritually starving.

In an effort to capitalize this vision, we are asking each member of our local parishes to donate \$80 towards the project (there are an estimated 1,000 Orthodox living in greater Harrisburg).
