The Nativity (St. Philip's) Fast: Sun, November 15th – Fri, December 25th The *prescription* of the Church (think of it just like a prescription given by a doctor) is to use these 40 days preceding the Great Feast of Nativity (i.e. Christmas) to prepare the "cave of our hearts" to receive Christ. A feature of this prescription/medicine is the increased emphasis on the spiritual exercise of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. The dietary fast calls for abstention from all meat and dairy products, but more importantly to use this discipline as a means for spiritual health and abstention from "consuming" our neighbors and being overrun with materialism and despair.
