**DORMITION FAST:** Please note that we, along with nearly 150 million Orthodox Christians throughout the world, will begin a two week fasting period on **Sunday, August 1<sup>st</sup> through Sunday, August 15<sup>th</sup>**, as we prepare for the feast of the Dormition (or falling asleep) of the Mother of God. The normal fasting standard is to abstain from all meat and dairy products for the duration of the fast. More importantly, we are encouraged to increase our daily prayers and learn about the feast we are preparing for (you can "Google" it!), and how it applies to our life and ultimately our salvation.
