Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone IV — When the women-disciples-of-the-Lord learnt, from the angel, the joyous message of Thy resurrection, they cast away the ancestral curse, and, elatedly, told the apostles: 'Death is overthrown; Christ God is risen, granting, unto the world, great mercy'.

Troparion, Tone IV — By the providence of God, thou wast sent to the mountain of Pochaev, for the knowledge of the truth of the Orthodox faith; and, receiving true teaching in the city of Zhitomir, as a soldier of Christ, thou camest to our land: for Orthodoxy, and thine own people, thou hast accepted a martyr's crown; wherefore, thou hast confirmed thy native land in Orthodoxy; O priest-martyr Maksym, pray to Christ God, that our souls may be saved.

 ${\cal G}^{ ext{ospel:}}$ (Matthew 21:33-42) The Lord told this parable: "There was a certain landowner who planted a vineyard and set a hedge around it, dug a winepress in it and built a tower. And he leased it to vinedressers and went into a far country. ³⁴ Now when vintage-time drew near, he sent his servants to the vinedressers, that they might receive its fruit. ³⁵ And the vinedressers took his servants, beat one, killed one, and stoned another. ³⁶ Again he sent other servants, more than the first, and they did likewise to them. ³⁷ Then last of all he sent his son to them, saying, 'They will respect my son.' 38 But when the vinedressers saw the son, they said among themselves, 'This is the heir. Come, let us kill him and seize his inheritance.' ³⁹ So they took him and cast him out of the vineyard and killed him. 40 "Therefore, when the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those vinedressers?" ⁴¹They said to Him, "He will destroy those wicked men miserably, and lease his vineyard to other vinedressers who will render to him the fruits in their seasons." 42 Jesus said to them, "Have you never read in the Scriptures: 'The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone. This was the LORD's doing, And it is marvelous in our eyes'?"

The parish council is seeking approval of **\$28,000** which would be funded by re-prioritizing the 2020 capital improvement budget. **NOTE**: We will also be streaming the meeting, as well as offering remote voting options for those unable to be physically present.
