Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone II —

When Thou didst descend to death, O life immortal, Thou didst slay hell with the splendour-of-Thy-Godhead; and, when, from the depths, Thou didst raise the dead, all the powers-of-heaven cried out: 'O giver-of-life, Christ our God, glory to Thee'.

Troparion, Tone I —

Rejoice, O Virgin Theotokos, full of grace; from thee, shone the sun of righteousness, Christ our God, enlightening those who sat in darkness: rejoice; and be glad, O righteous elder; thou didst accept, in thine arms, the redeemer of our souls, Who granteth us the resurrection.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone II —

Hell became afraid, O almighty Saviour, seeing the miracle of Thy resurrection-from-the-tomb; the dead arose: creation, with Adam, beheld this, and rejoiced with Thee; and the world, O my Saviour, praiseth Thee forever.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion, Tone I —

By Thy nativity, Thou didst sanctify the Virgin's womb, and didst bless Simeon's hands, O Christ God; now, Thou hast come, and saved us through love; grant peace to all Orthodox Christians, O only lover of man.



Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone 2: The Lord is my strength and my song; / He has become my salvation. (*Resurrection*)

v. The Lord has chastened me sorely, but He has not given me over to death.

Tone 3: My soul doth magnify the Lord, / and my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Savior. (Song of the Theotokos)

pistle: (1 Timothy 1:15-17) Timothy my son, this is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief. ¹⁶ However, for this reason I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might show all longsuffering, as a pattern to those who are going to believe on Him for everlasting life. ¹⁷ Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

Gospel: (Matthew 15:21-28) At that time: Jesus went out from there and departed to the region of Tyre and Sidon. ²² And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demonpossessed." ²³ But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, "Send her away, for she cries out after us." ²⁴ But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." ²⁵ Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, help me!" ²⁶ But He answered and said, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw *it* to the little dogs." ²⁷ And she said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table." ²⁸ Then Jesus answered and said to her, "O woman, great *is* your faith! Let it be to you as you desire." And her daughter was healed from that very hour.
