#### Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone VI —

The angelic powers were at Thy tomb; the guards became as dead men: Mary stood by Thy grave, seeking Thy most-pure body; Thou didst capture hell, not being tempted by it: Thou didst come to the Virgin, granting life; O Lord, Who didst rise from the dead, glory to Thee.

#### Troparion, Tone VII —

Thou wast transfigured on the mountain, O Christ God, revealing Thy glory to Thy disciples, as far as they could bear it: let Thine everlasting light also shine upon us sinners, through the prayers of the Theotokos; O giver of light, glory to Thee.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

#### Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone VI —

When Christ God, the giver of life, raised all of the dead from the valleys of misery with His mighty hand, He bestowed resurrection on the human race: He is the Saviour of all, the resurrection, the life, and the God of all.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

#### Kontakion, Tone VII —

On the mountain, Thou wast transfigured, O Christ God; and Thy disciples beheld Thy glory, as far as they could see it: so that, when they should behold Thee crucified, they would understand that Thy suffering was voluntary, and would proclaim, to the world, that Thou art, truly, the radiance of the Father.

pistle: (Romans 15:1-7) Brethren, we who are strong ought to bear with the scruples of the weak, and not to please ourselves. <sup>2</sup> Let each of us please his neighbor for his good, leading to edification. <sup>3</sup> For even Christ did not please Himself; but as it is written, "The reproaches of those who reproached You fell on Me." <sup>4</sup> For whatever things were written before were written for our learning, that we through the patience and comfort of the Scriptures might have hope. <sup>5</sup> Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like-minded toward one another, according to Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> that you may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>7</sup> Therefore receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God.

Gospel: (Matthew 9:27-35) At that time, two blind men followed Him, crying out and saying, "Son of David, have mercy on us!" <sup>28</sup> And when He had come into the house, the blind men came to Him. And Jesus said to them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" They said to Him, "Yes, Lord." <sup>29</sup> Then He touched their eyes, saying, "According to your faith let it be to you." <sup>30</sup> And their eyes were opened. And Jesus sternly warned them, saying, "See that no one knows it." <sup>31</sup> But when they had departed, they spread the news about Him in all that country. <sup>32</sup> As they went out, behold, they brought to Him a man, mute and demon-possessed. <sup>33</sup> And when the demon was cast out, the mute spoke. And the multitudes marveled, saying, "It was never seen like this in Israel!" <sup>34</sup> But the Pharisees said, "He casts out demons by the ruler of the demons." <sup>35</sup> Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.
