Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone V —

Let us, the faithful, praise, and worship, the Word, co-eternal with the Father, and the Spirit, born, for our salvation, from the Virgin: for He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh, to endure death, and to raise the dead, by His glorious resurrection.

Troparion, Tone IV —

Today is the prelude of the good will of God, of the preaching of the salvation of mankind; the Virgin appeareth in the temple of God, in anticipation, proclaiming Christ to all; let us rejoice, and sing to her: 'Rejoice, O fulfilment of the Creator's dispensation'.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.


Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone V —

Kontakion, Tone IV —

The most pure temple of the Saviour, the precious chamber and virgin, the sacred treasure of the glory of God, is presented, today, to the house of the Lord; she bringeth, with her, the grace of the Spirit; wherefore, the angels of God praise her: 'Truly, this woman is the abode of heaven'.



Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone 5: Thou, O Lord, shalt protect us / and preserve us from this generation forever. (*Resurrection*)

verse: Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer any that is godly!

Tone 3: My soul doth magnify the Lord, / and my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Savior. (Song of the Theotokos)

pistle: (Hebrews 9:1-7) Brethren, Then indeed, even the first covenant had ordinances of divine service and the earthly sanctuary. ² For a tabernacle was prepared: the first part, in which was the lampstand, the table, and the showbread, which is called the sanctuary; ³ and behind the second veil, the part of the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of All, ⁴ which had the golden censer and the ark of the covenant overlaid on all sides with gold, in which were the golden pot that had the manna, Aaron's rod that budded, and the tablets of the covenant; ⁵ and above it were the cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat. Of these things we cannot now speak in detail. ⁶ Now when these things had been thus prepared, the priests always went into the first part of the tabernacle, performing the services. ⁷ But into the second part the high priest went alone once a year, not without blood, which he offered for himself and for the people's sins committed in ignorance;

Gospel: (Luke 10:38-42; 11:27-28) At that time, Now it happened as they went that He entered a certain village; and a certain woman named Martha welcomed Him into her house. ³⁹ And she had a sister called Mary, who also sat at Jesus' feet and heard His word. ⁴⁰ But Martha was distracted with much serving, and she approached Him and said, "Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Therefore tell her to help me." ⁴¹ And Jesus answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things. ⁴² But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her." ²⁷ And it happened, as He spoke these things, that a certain woman from the crowd raised her voice and said to Him, "Blessed *is* the womb that bore You, and *the* breasts which nursed You!" ²⁸ But He said, "More than that, blessed *are* those who hear the word of God and keep it!"
