Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone VII —

By Thy cross, Thou didst destroy death; to the thief, Thou didst open paradise: for the myrrh-bearers, Thou didst change weeping into joy; and Thou didst command Thy disciples: O Christ God, to proclaim that Thou art risen, granting the world great mercy.

Troparion, Tone VIII —

With the streams of thy tears, thou hast tilled the fruitless desert, which, also, out of the deeps of sighs, in an hundred-fold labours, thou hast made fruitful, and hast become a lamp for all the inhabited world, shining with wonders, O Sabbas, our father: pray thou unto Christ God that He may save our souls.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone VIII —

From thy childhood, unto God, as a blameless sacrifice, hast thou offered thyself in virtue, O blessed Sabbas, becoming a gardener of piety: wherefore now, thou hast been an adornment for the venerable, as well as a right-praiseworthy citizen of the desert; wherefore now, we cry to thee: 'Rejoice, O Sabbas most-rich'.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone VII —

The dominion of death can, no longer, hold men captive: for Christ descended, shattering, and destroying, its powers; hell is bound, while the prophets rejoice, and cry: 'The Saviour hath come to them in faith; enter, ye faithful, into the resurrection'.

pistle: (Ephesians 2:14-22) Brethren, Jesus Christ Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation, ¹⁵ having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, ¹⁶ and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity. ¹⁷ And He came and preached peace to you who were afar off and to those who were near. ¹⁸ For through Him we both have access by one Spirit to the Father. ¹⁹ Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, ²⁰ having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, ²¹ in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, ²² in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit.

Gospel: (Luke 17:12-19) At that time, as Jesus entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off.

And they lifted up their voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" 14 So when He saw them, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed. 15 And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, 16 and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan. 17 So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? 18 Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."


