#### Third Antiphon

<u>Troparion</u>: Thy Nativity, O Christ our God, has shone to the world the light of wisdom! For by it, those who worshipped the stars, were taught by a star, to adore Thee the Sun of righteousness, and to know Thee, the Orient from on high.// O Lord, glory to Thee!

Reader: Until I make thine enemies Thy footstool! Troparion

**Reader**: The Lord sends forth from Zion Thy mighty scepter. Rule in the midst of Thy foes. <u>Troparion</u>

**Reader**: Authority shall be with Thee on the day of Thy power, among the splendor of Thy holy ones! <u>Troparion</u>

Entrance Verse: "Our of the womb before the morning star have I begotten Thee." The Lord has sworn and will not change His mind: "Thou are a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek".

<u>Troparion</u>: Thy Nativity, O Christ our God, has shone to the world the light of wisdom! For by it, those who worshipped the stars, were taught by a star, to adore Thee the Sun of righteousness, and to know Thee, the Orient from on high.// O Lord, glory to Thee!

**Kontakion:** Today the Virgin gives birth to the Transcendent One, and the earth offers a cave to the Unapproachable One. Angels with shepherds glorify Him; the Wise Men journey with the star,// since for our sake the eternal God was born as a little Child!

**Prokeimenon in the 8th tone:** Let all the earth worship Thee and praise Thee! Let it praise Thy Name, O Most High!

Verse: Make a joyful noise to God, all the earth! Sing of His Name! Give glory to His praise!

pistle (Galatians 4:4-7): Brethren, when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

#### **Alleluia Verses**

The heavens are telling the glory of God, and the firmament proclaims His handiwork.

Day to day pours forth speech, and night to night declare knowledge.

Gospel (Matthew 2:1-12): At that time, Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, saying, "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him." When Herod the king heard this, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. So they said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it is written by the prophet: But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are not the least among the rulers of Judah; For out of you shall come a Ruler Who will shepherd My people Israel." Then Herod, when he had secretly called the wise men, determined from them what time the star appeared. And he sent them to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search carefully for the young Child, and when you have found Him, bring back word to me, that I may come and worship Him also." When they heard the king, they departed; and behold, the star which they had seen in the East went before them, till it came and stood over where the young Child was. When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceedingly great joy. And when they had come into the house, they saw the young Child with Mary His mother, and fell down and worshiped Him. And when they had opened their treasures, they presented gifts to Him: gold, frankincense, and myrrh. 12 Then, being divinely warned in a dream that they should not return to Herod, they departed for their own country another way.


