### Hymns & Readings

**Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone VII** — By Thy cross, Thou didst destroy death; to the thief, Thou didst open paradise: for the myrrh-bearers, Thou didst change weeping into joy; and Thou didst command Thy disciples: O Christ God, to proclaim that Thou art risen, granting the world great mercy.

**Troparion, Tone I** — Let us, who love their words, come together, with hymns, and honour the three great torch-bearers of the triune Godhead: Basil the Great, Gregory the Theologian, and John Chrysostom; these men have enlightened the world with the rays of their divine doctrines; they are sweetly-flowing rivers of wisdom, filling all creation with springs of heavenly knowledge; they, ceaselessly, intercede, for us, before the Holy Trinity.

**Troparion, Tone IV** — As sharers of the apostles' life and character, and teachers of the universe, intercede with the Master of all to grant peace to the world, and great mercy to our souls.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

**Kontakion, Tone II** — The sacred and godly-proclaiming heralds, and foremost among teachers, O Lord, Thou hast received into the enjoyment of Thy good things, and into rest: for their labours and death hast Thou accepted as surpassing any whole-burnt offering, O Thou only-one that art glorified in Thy saints.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

**Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone VII** — The dominion of death can, no longer, hold men captive: for Christ descended, shattering, and destroying, its powers; hell is bound, while the prophets rejoice, and cry: 'The Saviour hath come to them in faith; enter, ye faithful, into the resurrection'.

**Tone 7:** The Lord shall give strength to His people. / The Lord shall bless His people with peace. (*Resurrection*)

verse: Offer to the Lord, O you sons of God! Offer young rams to the Lord!

**Tone 8:** Their proclamation has gone out into all the earth, / and their words to the ends of the universe. (Three Hierarchs)

pistle: (Hebrews 13:7-16) Brethren, remember those who rule over you, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow, considering the outcome of their conduct. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines. For it is good that the heart be established by grace, not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them. We have an altar from which those who serve the tabernacle have no right to eat. For the bodies of those animals, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned outside the camp. Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate. Therefore let us go forth to Him, outside the camp, bearing His reproach. For here we have no continuing city, but we seek the one to come. Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name. But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

**Alleluia Verses:** It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praises to Thy Name, O Most High.

To declare Thy mercy in the morning, and Thy truth by night.

The heavens will praise Thy wonders, O Lord; and Thy truth in the congregation of the saints.

Gospel: (Matthew 15:21-28) At that time, Jesus went out from there and departed to the region of Tyre and Sidon. <sup>22</sup> And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demonpossessed." <sup>23</sup> But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, "Send her away, for she cries out after us." <sup>24</sup> But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." <sup>25</sup> Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, help me!" <sup>26</sup> But He answered and said, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw *it* to the little dogs." <sup>27</sup> And she said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table." <sup>28</sup> Then Jesus answered and said to her, "O woman, great *is* your faith! Let it be to you as you desire." And her daughter was healed from that very hour.
