Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone VII —

By Thy cross, Thou didst destroy death; to the thief, Thou didst open paradise: for the myrrh-bearers, Thou didst change weeping into joy; and Thou didst command Thy disciples: O Christ God, to proclaim that Thou art risen, granting the world great mercy.

Troparion, Tone IV —

As thou sharedst in the ways of the apostles, and occupiedst their throne, thou foundest thine activity to be a way to the vision of God, O divinely inspired one. Wherefore, ordering the word of truth, thou sufferedst for the Faith even to the shedding of thy blood. O hieromartyr Phocas, entreat Christ God that our souls be saved.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone I —

Turning from the art of sorcery to the knowledge of God, O godly-inspired one, thou hast been shewn forth as a skilful healer for the world, granting cures to them that honour thee, O Cyprian, together with Justina: with her, pray thou to the Master that loveth mankind, that He may save our souls.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone VII —

The dominion of death can, no longer, hold men captive: for Christ descended, shattering, and destroying, its powers; hell is bound, while the prophets rejoice, and cry: 'The Saviour hath come to them in faith; enter, ye faithful, into the resurrection'.

Prokeimenon & Readings:

Tone 7: The Lord shall give strength to His people. / The Lord shall bless His people with peace. (*Resurrection*)

Verse: Offer to the Lord, O you sons of God! Offer young rams to the Lord!

Epistle: (*2 Corinthians 6:1-10*) Brethren, as workers together with Him also plead with you not to receive the grace of God in vain. ²For He says: "In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you." Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation. ³We give no offense in anything, that our ministry may not be blamed. ⁴But in all things we commend ourselves as ministers of God: in much patience, in tribulations, in needs, in distresses, ⁵in stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in sleeplessness, in fastings; ⁶by purity, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Spirit, by sincere love, ⁷by the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left, ⁸by honor and dishonor, by evil report and good report; as deceivers, and yet true; ⁹as unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and behold we live; as chastened, and yet not killed; ¹⁰as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things.

Alleluia Verses:

Gospel: (*Luke 6:31-36*) Jesus said, "Just as you want men to do to you, you also do to them likewise. ³²"But if you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners do the same. ³⁴And if you lend to *those* from whom you hope to receive back, what credit is that to you? For even sinners lend to sinners to receive as much back. ³⁵But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil. ³⁶Therefore be merciful, just as your Father also is merciful."
