## Hymns & Readings

**Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone III** — Let the heavens rejoice; let the earth be glad: for the Lord hath shewn strength with His arm; He hath trampled down death by death; He hath become the first-born of the dead; He hath delivered us from the depths of hell, and hath granted, unto the world, great mercy.

**Troparion, Tone VIII** — With the streams of thy tears, thou hast tilled the fruitless desert, which, also, out of the deeps of sighs, in an hundred -fold labours, thou hast made fruitful, and hast become a lamp for all the inhabited world, shining with wonders, O Pimen, our father: pray thou unto Christ God that He may save our souls.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

**Kontakion, Tone IV** — The memorial of thine illustrious struggles delighteth the souls of the devout today, O Pimen, our venerable father wise in God.

**Tone III:** Sing praises to our God, sing praises! / Sing praises to our King, sing praises! (*Resurrection*)

Verse: Clap your hands, all peoples! Shout to God with loud songs of joy!

**T**pistle: (1 Corinthians 15:1-11) Brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, <sup>2</sup> by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. <sup>3</sup> For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, <sup>4</sup> and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, <sup>5</sup> and that He was seen by Over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. <sup>7</sup> After that He was seen by James, then by

all the apostles. <sup>8</sup> Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time. <sup>9</sup> For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. <sup>10</sup> But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me. <sup>11</sup> Therefore, whether it was I or they, so we preach and so you believed.

#### Alleluia Verses:

In Thee, O Lord, have I hoped; let me never be put to shame!

 $G_{\text{to Him}, \text{``Good Teacher}, \text{ what good thing shall I do that I may have}}$ eternal life?" <sup>17</sup> So He said to him, "Why do you call Me good? No one is good but One, that is, God. But if you want to enter into life, keep the commandments." <sup>18</sup> He said to Him, "Which ones?" Jesus said, "'You shall not murder,' 'You shall not commit adultery,' 'You shall not steal,' 'You shall not bear false witness,' <sup>19</sup> 'Honor your father and your mother,' and, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' "<sup>20</sup>The young man said to Him, "All these things I have kept from my youth. What do I still lack?"<sup>21</sup> Jesus said to him, "If you want to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me." <sup>22</sup> But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.<sup>23</sup>Then Jesus said to His disciples, "Assuredly, I say to you that it is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven.<sup>24</sup> And again I say to you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God." <sup>25</sup> When His disciples heard it, they were greatly astonished, saying, "Who then can be saved?" <sup>26</sup>But Jesus looked at them and said to them, "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."
